Specifics: All original forms of art are welcome with the following size limitations:

- Wall mounted: 24 x 36 in. or 36 x 24 in. (need not be framed but prepared for hanging)
- Pedestal: 24 x 24 in. Floor: 48 (high) x 24 in.

Judging: Area art professionals will select one winner out of 6 finalists in each category. The winners and finalists will be presented with a ribbon by the Mayor of Highland Park at a January 6, 2012 reception at The Art Center.

The winning and finalist works will be exhibited at The Art Center during the entire month of January 2012.
